Course Duration

Three day public training course with the COBIT5 Implementation certification exam on day three (3).

Course Overview

The course empowers delegates with:

- Knowledge and understanding of the COBIT5 Implementation approach,
- Skills to assess the current state of their enterprise with the objective of scoping the aspects of the COBIT5 framework that would be appropriate to implement,
- Preparation for COBIT5 implementation certification exam.

Course Objective

The course provides knowledge and guidance for application of the concepts of COBIT5 implementation, with focus on the following areas:

- COBIT5 overview and GEIT (Governance of Enterprise IT).
- Creating the appropriate environment.
- Overview of the implementation phases plus application methods.
- Structure and content of the COBIT5 implementation guide.

Course Format

- The course is presented in an instructor led classroom style.
- A combination of lectures, group discussions, course revision, and sample exam questions will be used.
- The course prepare delegates for the COBIT5 implementation certificate exam.

Exam

- The exam is an open book (COBIT5 implementations guide), complex, multiple choice examination.
- It comprises of 80 questions in 4 sections, lasting for 150 minutes.
- The pass score is 50% (40 out of 80).
- Some students may need additional time.

Who should attend?

The course is for:

- Consultants who want to learn how to implement or use COBIT5 for different scenarios for client initiatives.
- IT professionals who want practitioner level training and an appreciation of how to use the COBIT5 framework for their different organisational scenarios.
- Business managers who want to have a more practical appreciation on how to apply COBIT5 to their specific business problems, pain point, trigger events and risk scenarios.

Structure

- It is lectured-based, with assignments to reinforce the key learning topics for each of the phases of implementation.
- It is predominantly based on the COBIT5 implementation guide.
- The assignments also give some insight into practical application and methods involved.
